The 44th annual NYSABE Conference will be held virtually from April 4 to 9th. The pre-conference will be from April 4th - 6th and the general Conference from April 7th - 9th. The Pre-Conference will provide workshops for parents highlighting current trends in understanding social, linguistic, and educational issues facing our multilingual learners. In addition, the conference itself will explore topics with educators in the field of bilingual education through its theme, ***RECLAIMING SOCIAL JUSTICE IN BILINGUAL EDUCATION FOR MULTILINGUAL LEARNERS: THE TIME IS NOW!***

All educators, parents, students, researchers, publishers, elected officials, and community-based organizations representatives are welcome to share their expertise and experiences with participants at the 2022 Virtual Conference. Since the conference is virtual, the sessions will begin from 4:00 PM-8:00 PM weekdays and on Saturday, April 9, 2022, from 8:30 AM-1:30 PM.

This year's conference theme is a call to reflect upon linguistic opportunities, social issues concerning our students, and the educational strategies that reflect on the rich diversity of our students. We must rethink what's in our classrooms and how we must educate and prepare all of our students for a multilingual and multicultural world as we transform our schools.

The conference sessions should provide resources, strategies, ideas, and inspiring direction for educators, researchers, parents/family members, students, and other stakeholders involved in the education of multilingual learners.

We strongly encourage proposals to connect to the conference theme: the education of English-language learners/Multilingual learners in all academic areas,

e.g., bilingual, ENL, special education, general education, and integrated English as a new language.

NYSABE aspires that all workshops will offer high-quality professional development opportunities for attendees, and therefore, all proposal submissions will be evaluated based on the following criteria:

- Quality of title and abstract
- Clarity of purpose and objectives included in the description
- Alignment of presentation description and abstract
- Relevance, research-based, and current topic
- Connection to the conference theme

IMPORTANT: INFORMATION FOR YOUR CONSIDERATION BEFORE SUBMISSION:

- Workshops are virtual and 50 minutes in length. All workshop presentations should allow 10 minutes at the end of the session for questions and to reflect on the learning.
- You may present alone or with a partner or team.
- ALL presenters must register for the conference and pay as attendees.
- Since the conference is ‘virtual,’ there is only one fee to register. Once confirmed to present, you will receive more logistical information.
- PowerPoint presentations are preferred.
- Presenters should be familiar with zoom and all its characteristics.

- Presenters must secure their access to internet service to be able to present.
- If you plan to show video clips, they must be loaded onto your laptop or desktop and tested beforehand to ensure they are working.
- Secure your remote zoom space to maintain a quiet and professional environment.
- Presenters are recommended to attend a short training on the virtual platform.

NOTIFICATION:

A conference committee consisting of NYSABE members, leadership, and directors will convene in February to review all proposals and select which ones to include in the program. In addition, the proposals considered will be evaluated for quality, usefulness to attendees, and their contribution to a balanced program. Everyone who submits a proposal will receive a notice via email by **February 11, 2022**.
