**NIVIA ZAVALA SPECIAL ART CONTEST
FOR ELL/MULTILINGUAL LEARNERS WITH DISABILITIES**

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:

The contest is limited to ELL/multilingual learners currently enrolled in bilingual and/or ENL programs in New York State.

ARTWORK CRITERIA:

- Each entry must be accompanied by an application form.
- **Conference Theme: RECLAIMING SOCIAL JUSTICE IN BILINGUAL EDUCATION FOR MULTILINGUAL LEARNERS: THE TIME IS NOW!**
 - Possible themes: collaboration, leadership, equity, diversity, and/or unity in bilingual education
- Teachers should assist students to ensure that artwork submissions meet the following criteria:
 - Creativity
 - Originality
 - Detail
- Artwork must be submitted on paper no larger than 11" x 14".
- Students may use any medium (crayons, paint, pencils, etc.). Photographs will not be accepted.
- Artwork will not be returned. Accepted artwork may be featured in the NYSABE Conference program and Newsletter

- Only work done by individual students will be accepted. No group entries will be considered.

PRIZES/AWARDS:

Winning entries may be published in NYSABE's *The Bilingual Times Newsletter*. First, second and third place winners at each of the following grade clusters will be chosen: **3-5, 6-8, and 9-12.**

1st PLACE WINNER: medal and gift of \$150.00

2nd PLACE WINNER: medal and gift of \$100.00

3rd PLACE WINNER: medal and a gift of \$50.00

The awards will be presented on **Tuesday, April 5, 2022** at the Student Award Session during the **NYSABE 44th Annual Conference** held virtually. **Winners must be present at NYSABE's virtual conference on Tuesday, April 5, 2022. Winners, teachers and their parents will be provided with a zoom link.**

JUDGING: Once the submissions are received, a committee of judges, selected by the Committee Chairperson, will review the art based on the outlined criteria. This committee will determine the 1st-3rd place winners in each grade cluster. The committee's decisions are final. Winners will be notified no later than **March 12, 2022.**
