The focus of the Parent Institute for the conference on **April 4th** will be to provide workshops for parents/families highlighting current trends in understanding social, linguistic, and educational issues faced by our multilingual learners. In addition, the conference on **April 4th-6th** will explore topics with educators in the field of bilingual education through its theme.

This year's conference theme, *EMPOWERING MULTILINGUAL STUDENT VOICES TO ADVOCATE FOR THE THEIR RIGHT TO BILINGUAL EDUCATION*, is a call to reflect upon the way we position and empower our students to advocate for themselves and their peers to their right for bilingual education. We ask you to join us as presenters and submit proposals that highlight the transformative work that continues to shift the paradigm of how we approach the teaching and learning of multilingual learners, especially in terms of building student agency and advocacy. It is critical that we, as a learning community, take our lessons learned and share with one another in pushing the boundaries of our schools and classrooms to empower all our students for a multilingual and multicultural world.

The conference sessions should provide resources, strategies, ideas, and inspiring direction for educators, researchers, parents/family members, students, and other stakeholders involved in the education of multilingual learners. **We strongly encourage proposals to connect to the conference theme** in all academic areas, e.g., bilingual education, English as a New Language, special education, general education, and world languages. Suggested topics may include (but not limited to):

- Bilingual/Bicultural Approaches
- Social-Emotional Learning
- Asset-Based Approaches
- Culturally and Linguistically Responsive Education
- Setting Instructional Goals
- Diversity-Equity-Inclusive (DEI) Instructional Practices
- Integrating Cultural Perspectives
- Empowerment

CRITERIA FOR PROPOSALS:

NYSABE aspires that all workshops offer high-quality professional learning opportunities for our guests; therefore, all proposal submissions will be evaluated through a double-blind review process and evaluated based on the following criteria:

- Quality of title and abstract
- Clarity of purpose and objectives included in the description
- Alignment of presentation description and abstract
- Relevance, research-based, and current topic
- Connection to the conference theme

IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR YOUR CONSIDERATION BEFORE SUBMISSION:

Workshops will be either 40 or 90 minutes in length. All workshop presentations should allow 10 minutes at the end of the session for questions and to reflect on the learning. You may present alone or with a partner or team.

ALL presenters must register for the conference and pay as attendees.

- Once confirmed to present, you will receive more detailed information about your specific presentation (time, location, etc.)
- PowerPoint presentations are preferred.
- Please ensure that all submissions are proofread and edited.

NOTIFICATION:

- A conference committee consisting of NYSABE members, leadership, and directors will convene in January to review all proposals and select which ones to include in the program.
- The proposals considered will be evaluated for quality, usefulness to attendees, and their contribution to a balanced program.
- All who submit a proposal will receive a notice via email by **February 16, 2024**.
